



## Youth Medallion

TWHBEA will provide a medallion, first through fifth place ribbons, and premiums for (up to) the top five placings to any horse show that includes either or both Youth Medallion classes in their slate of classes.

Guidelines for the Youth Medallion Classes are:

- Open to all youth riders, age 17 and under (age as of January 1).
- Ownership of the horse is not required. Stallions are not allowed.
- Two Medallion classes may be offered, Youth Medallion Performance and Youth Medallion Pleasure. In both classes, horses should perform all three gaits - flat walk, running walk, and canter. Show managers may choose to offer one or both of these classes.
- **Horses entered in either of these classes should not be charged an entry fee.**
- **Horses entered in either of these classes at SHOW affiliated horse shows will be charged a \$5 inspection fee.**
- **Premiums for both Youth Medallion classes will be: \$100, \$75, \$50, \$40, \$30(to be paid by TWHBEA)**
